The outpouring of love was tremendous, and we are so thankful for all the prayers and kindness that have surrounded us through this incredibly hard journey.

Jeffrey's funeral was a true testament to the impact he had. Over 300 people filled our little town hall, with many more watching online. One thing that shone through that day was how deeply he had touched so many lives while faithfully doing what God had called him to do here on earth. Our daughter, Shynese, wrote a very special tribute to her Dad, and I would like to share a little of that with you.



'Anyone who knew my dad could tell you: he lit up every room he walked into. It wasn't just his presence—it was the way he made every single person feel heard and seen.'

He truly listened. He didn't just ask how you were doing—he cared. He asked questions because he wanted to understand your world, so he could offer advice that was thoughtful, personal and full of wisdom.

He always said that 80% of what we do is for other people. And it was clear he meant that. He lived it every day. His mission in Honduras was to help others—and that's exactly what he did. Nobody here can fully grasp the legacy he leaves there, or the countless lives he not only changed, but saved. His commitment to the people of Honduras was profound. He didn't just recognize their need—he took action. His gentle and loving heart led the way.'

That truly sums up his love for people—both here and in Honduras. Many donations have been lovingly made in his name, and in the next few weeks, Shynese, Aaden, and I will be heading to Honduras to find a project that will honour his legacy. Please be patient with us as we continue to grieve this great loss to our family and our ministry. We will spend a couple of weeks there before returning home before Christmas.

We are so thankful for our capable staff in Honduras, who have carried on so faithfully through these difficult days. And to answer the many questions we've received—yes, we will most definitely continue with

Brighter Horizons. Our hearts have not changed. Honduras is our second home, and we are so grateful that we will be able to attend graduation at the school this fall when we return. It will certainly be a difficult trip, but we know and trust that God has a purpose for everything He does, and we lean into our faith daily to carry us through.
